

## THE "LORDS", LUGAL-LUGAL, OF EBLA A PROSOPOGRAPHIC STUDY\*

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### 0. *The mu-DU texts*

There are three kinds of texts which, year after year and for roughly forty years, document the administrative activities of the palatial organisation of Ebla: 1) the monthly accounts of the distribution of cloth (RMT); 2) the annual accounts of the distribution of precious metals, normally in the form of objects (RAM); 3) texts relating to the deliveries, mu-DU, to the Palace of metals and cloth by the minister (or vizier) and the "lords", lugal-lugal.<sup>1</sup> The first category was created when Arrukum was minister. During the same period, also the RAMs began to be drawn up. Numerous mu-DU texts, some of which are annual accounts, date back to the period prior to Arrukum and these represent the earliest group of documents in the central archive, possibly having been transferred there from a previous archive. The RAM and mu-DU documents took on their definitive form under Ibrium, Arrukum's successor.

None of these documents is dated by year, with the very few exceptions drawn up on the occasion of particular events such as the death of the mother of the king or the death of the vizier Ibrium. Notwithstanding this, it has been possible to assign a fairly certain chronological order to the RAMs of the ministers Ibrium and Ibbi-Zikir by taking into consideration the personalities mentioned therein and the occasions on which deliveries were made

(expeditions, marriages, births and deaths).<sup>2</sup> Thanks to the wealth of information they contain, the RAMs represent the basis for chronological ordering of the documentary material as it is possible to correlate, for example, certain RMTs with the RAMs.<sup>3</sup>

The mu-DU texts relate both to annual deliveries and goods delivered on particular occasions. The format of the annual document, beginning with Ibrium, consists of four sections: I) deliveries by the vizier: mu-DU *Ib-ri-um / I-bi-zikir*, which are by far the greatest; II) deliveries by the lords, mu-DU *lugal-lugal*;<sup>4</sup> III) deliveries by the city-states under Ebla's control; IV) totals of the goods consigned.<sup>5</sup> TM.75.G.1297 gives, for example:

I mu-DU *Ib-ri-um*: 636;00 minas of silver, 10;12 minas of gold, 820;00 minas of copper (a-gar<sub>5</sub>-gar<sub>5</sub>), 2,840 clothings (túg-túg), 2,506 kilts (ib-TUG)

II mu-DU *lugal-lugal*: 62;50 minas of silver

III mu-DU *nig-ki-za en* "deliveries pertaining to the king": 15;53 minas of silver, 6;47 minas of gold

IV Totals: 714;43 minas of silver, 17;00 minas of gold, 2,999 clothings, 2,700 kilts.

The presence or absence of certain lords enables us to determine a chronological sequence, albeit approximate.<sup>6</sup> We may thus follow the goods entering the Palace year after year. On the basis of this chronological order we may, moreover, approximately date documents of other administrative sectors in which these same "lords", *lugal-lugal*, appear.

For the final period, that of the minister Ibbi-Zikir, we have one text, TM.75.G.2271, which records a total of 287;33 minas of gold and a hundred of so minas of silver "the property (ZA<sub>1</sub>) of Ibbi-Zikir", to decorate objects in his

possession. The quantities are recorded year after year, for 17 years, clearly those during which Ibbi-Zikir was minister. For 5 of these 17 no deliveries were made: nu-mu-DU. In certain cases it is possible to identify these quantities of metals in the first section of the annual mu-DU texts; these deal, therefore, with a delivery by Ibbi-Zikir, mu-DU *I-bi-zi-kir*, listed among the deliveries for the Palace but destined for the minister's personal use. See *ARET VIII 528*, a mu-DU text which we can now date to the 13th year of the period in which Ibbi-Zikir was minister:

1. *The lords of the earliest period: reign of Igriš-Halab and beginning of Irkab-Damu's reign.*

There appear to be only four texts dated to the reign of Igriš-Halab, the third from last king: TM.75.G.1237, TM.77.G.23+80.G.207, and probably also TM.76.G.882 with TM.75.G.11430+11931+11937. The central archive which has survived until today began, therefore, under Irkab-Damu. This king has to be attributed with having built the audience courtyard (L.2752) together with the archive room (L.2769) and the vestibule (L.2875). These were created by using a section of the portico on the eastern side, near the staircase leading to the interior of the royal Palace.

Text Ib 1 (TM.75.G.1237), an inventory of "lance heads", GIŠ-gu-kak-gid-Šub, the colophon of which dates it to Igriš-Halab (... *Ig-ri-iš-Ha-lab<sub>1</sub> en Ib-laki*).<sup>7</sup> shows that Darmia, Tir, Gugewan son of Igi and Dubišum ur<sub>4</sub> were "lords" already at the time of this king.

Ib 2 (TM.77.G.23+80.G.207) opens with quantities of gold and silver at the time of the fifth from last king, Kun-Damu; there then follows the silver consigned by the city of Abarsal and further silver attributed to Igriš-Halab. This document shows how Gigi and Ibazinu (together with Dubišum, mentioned

also in the preceding texts), held office as collectors of silver already during the reign of Igriš-Ḫalab.

Ib 3 (TM.76.G.882) mentions Kešdut, as well as Tir and Darmia, who was perhaps the *maliktum* of Igriš-Ḫalab.<sup>8</sup>

Ib 4 (TM.75.G.11430+11931+11937), mainly fragmentary, provides a certain synchronism between some "lords" and Irkab-Damu. Ibazinu, Ibbi-Zikir, Ibu-Damu and Tir deliver (mu-DU) objects in precious metals and clothes to Irkab-Damu, who is perhaps not yet king since he is mentioned by his personal name.

While various documents were drawn up on particular occasions, others are to be seen as annual accounts, given certain internal factors and the totals of the quantities of goods delivered.

Among the *lugal-lugal* of the earliest period, Darmilu (*Dar-mi-lu*, mostly in the hypocoristic form *Dar-mi-a*) and Tir stand out from the other lords thanks to the value of their deliveries. They both begin their careers under Igriš-Ḫalab (Ib 1, 3, 4). Tir delivers more silver than Darmia, but far fewer clothes and objects:

Darmia would seem to have died 6 or 7 years before Tir, since he appears in less than half the number of texts which include the name of his colleague. Tir, however, did not succeed in becoming the head of the administration, Arrukum being chosen instead. Arrukum already appears in some documents of Darmia and the other "lords" who were active during the reign of Igriš-Ḫalab, that is Dubišum *ur4*, Gigi, Gugewan son of Igi, Ibazinu and Tir (Ib 1-3). Of these, Gugewan probably remained in office, together with Tir, with Arrukum as minister. When Ibrium replaced Arrukum, Tir also disappeared.

A chronological ordering of these texts is difficult since, in this period, the "lords", *lugal-lugal*, did not yet represent a fixed group, thus the presence or absence of one of them cannot be used as a certain element in establishing dates (see Table 1). Nor is it possible to establish the period of time covered by

the texts as they do not reflect a format that can be identified with any certainty as covering an entire year. The only criterion, therefore, is that of comparing the total of goods delivered with those of the earliest mu-DU texts of Ibrium's period. We must also bear in mind that while the annual documents of Ibrium and Ibbi-Zikir include both deliveries of metals and those of clothings, in the previous period two documents were sometimes drawn up, one for each kind of goods.

A very few tablets show the formula: x mu "xth year", a dating in use in the documents of Lagaš about of the same period of those from Ebla, where it refers to the year of the sovereign's reign. At Ebla, however, this is used in very few cases and in an apparently anomalous way since the documents cannot be ordered into series according to the number of the years. Text II 1, from the period in which Arrukum was minister and Ennai and Ibdur-išar the "judges", is dated: 3 mu. This should be followed by Ia 5 (relating only to clothing) since this is dated 4 mu. In this Arrukum holds a prominent position, but the "judges" are Ladat and Ennai, and we know that Ibdur-išar succeeded Ladat (see below). In Ia 4, dated 6 mu, Arrukum appears, but it is still Darmia who heads the administration and the "judges" are, in fact, Ladat and Ennai. The "judges" of Ia 7, dated 7 mu, are again Ladat and Ennai (the text is fragmentary). It is doubtful whether 7 mu in Ia 7 may refer to the period of the reign of Igriš-Halab and 3 mu of II 1 to the 3rd year of Irkab-Damu (II 2, 3 and 4 are not dated).

There is no reason to doubt that these judges administered justice (there are, however, no precise references to this activity). The function of the other lords was that of "overseeing" certain important sections of the administration. The term ugula is occasionally used instead of lugal, as in IV 1 (Ibbi-Zikir), where the usual formula mu-DU lugal-lugal is replaced by mu-DU ugula-ugula. In Ia 10 the lords are called ugula because they are listed as collectors of cattle and sheep. The term lugal was a title reflecting the status of such officials. Ennail is called both lugal and ugula IGI.NITA (index 1). Enna-damu is lugal and IÚ lāl, "responsible for the honey"; Titinu is also lugal / IÚ BAR.AN. For Enna-malik and Na'a-malik, only the title of "lord of the serfs" is attested, lugal ir<sub>11</sub>-ir<sub>11</sub>. Agi, Dubišum, Dunusagi, Igna-damu, IrNiBa and Kušar were ur<sub>4</sub>.

According to Ia 12 (to be dated to the time of king Irkab-Damu), a good 7,000 "workers", guruš, came under the lords, while the Palace had 4,700. The lords, therefore, had the task of organising certain sectors of work outside the city of Ebla and of collecting the deliveries of goods to the Palace such as cattle and

sheep.<sup>9</sup> Those lords who were overseers of villages, instead do not appear regularly in the mu-DU lists. For PN lugal GN, see *A-ma-lik*, *A-mu-ti*, *Dam-da-il*, *I-bi-šum*, *I-du-ba*, *I-gú-uš-li-im*, *I-ib-ma-lik*, *I-mu-da-mu*, *I-ti-NE*, *Ib-gú-i-šar*, *Ib-u<sub>9</sub>-da-mu*, *Ib-u<sub>9</sub>-mu-ud*, *Ib-su-ul-da-mu*, *Il-uš-li-im*, *Iš-má-da-mu*, *Iš<sub>1</sub>-gi-da-mu*, *Ki-li-im* (index 1); PN ugula GN: *Du-bí*, *En-na-i*, *Ig-na-da-ar*, *Iš<sub>11</sub>-ru<sub>12</sub>-ut*, *Ri-i-ma-lik* (indices 2-3).

Until the 2nd year of Ibrium (III 2), the lugal-lugal who directed the deliveries towards the palatial administration were not a closed group. Numerous documents recording goods delivered on particular occasions (the Ib texts) belong to this earlier phase where, alongside the more frequently mentioned lugal-lugal, others appear, some not mentioned anywhere else (see in particular Ib 8 and 17). It was Ibrium who, at the time that Ebla was imposing itself as a regional state, gave a more solid structure to the administration.

#### 2. The lords contemporary of minister Arrukum; reign of Irkab-Damu

Arrukum perhaps came from *Lu-da-u<sub>9</sub>kī* (ib 11), a place not attested in other documents. The first text attributed to Arrukum as minister is perhaps II 1. According to this document, Arrukum delivers the same amount of unworked silver (100 minas) as Tir, by then already one of the most important lords for some years, together with Darmilu. Arrukum, however, also delivers silver and gold objects, of the respective value of 10 and 12 minas, as well as several hundred pieces of clothing. The section recording his deliveries concludes the document. In the other three texts, II 2, 3 and 4, this section is, instead, placed at the beginning and this order is used also in his successors' records, those of Ibrium and Ibbi-Zikir.

We cannot rule out the possibility that texts Ia 22, 23 and 24, listed in the previous paragraph, are to be attributed to the period of Arrukum's supremacy. Their fragmentary state prevents their being placed in a certain chronology.

### 3. The lords of minister Ibrium; reign of Išar-Damu

Arrukum was succeeded by Ibrium, who already appears in the lists of the period following Darmilu, when Tir was first among the lords. In the documents of Arrukum (II 1 and 2), he does not hold an important position.<sup>11</sup> His

nomination to minister seems to have marked a break with the previous administration, if we may base such suppositions purely on administrative documents.

There are 18 annual mu-DU texts of Ibrium. Only a few of these are annotated: mu-DU 1 mu "deliveries (of) one year" (III 2, 4, 8, 9, 11). There is no doubt, however, that the others were also annual: they all (with the exception of III 1) have the same format of four sections described above (section 0). A further four texts (IIIa 1-4) record deliveries of the "lords", *lugal-lugal*, on particular occasions; that relating to the priestess Tinib-Dulum (III 4) is dated to the final years of Ibrium or the first of Ibbi-Zikir.<sup>12</sup>

The annual accounts of deliveries of precious metals (RAMs) attributed to Ibrium number 17, one fewer than the mu-DU texts. This difference may be due to the fact that one fragmentary RAM has not yet been identified. It is also possible that the accounting of RAMs concluded in a different month and, thus, an annual account fell in the period of the previous or successive minister.

The last of the mu-DU texts is III 18, drawn up the year of Ibrium's death: DIS mu ug<sub>7</sub> *Ib-ri-um*. The sequence of the other documents is uncertain. Text III 1 has been considered the first since it does not yet show the four-part structure discussed above (which, however, has been used already in two mu-DU texts of Arrukum, II 1, 2), and the deliveries made by Ibrium are recorded in the middle of the text rather than at the beginning. Text III 1 gives exceptionally a date: the year following the death of the king, 2 mu ug<sub>7</sub> en, who must be Irkab-Damu. Other texts (TM.75.G.1462; MEE X 4) would seem to demonstrate that in the year of this king's death, Ibrium already held the position of minister.<sup>13</sup> Should III 1, therefore, be preceded by another mu-DU text?

An initial chronological order is given by the sequence of names of the "judges". Ennai (/ Ennani-il) and Ibdur-išar, who held such positions already before Arrukum was minister, appear in III 1-4. The post of Ibdur-išar is then taken by Iram-dar (III 5-8) who is, in turn, soon replaced by Iš-damu (III 9-11). When Ennai disappears, after possibly 19 years' service, Ile-išar is alongside Iš-damu. The sequence of judges is thus as follows: III 1-4: Ennai (Ennani-il in

Ibrium changed practically all of the lords; evidently his reforms did not affect only the accounting. Tir, already in service under king Igriš-Halab, retired with the disappearance of Arrukum, possibly due to old age. Abu (III 1) and Irda-malik (III 2, 3), active for many years with Darmilu and Tir, disappeared in the very first years of Ibrium. Of those "lords" chosen by Ibrium, Dubi already appeared in the documents of Arrukum's last year. Others, such as Hara-il, Išgi-ba'ir and Ri'i-malik are attested in one or two previous documents; ZAZALUM appears only in III 2 (see Table II).

#### 4. The lords of minister Ibbi-Zikir; reign of Išar-Damu

With Ibbi-Zikir there is a notable increase in goods delivered to the Palace by the minister, while the lords continue their contributions on the same level as before. Hara-il, who was already first lord at the beginning of Ibrium's term, continues to give his 12 minas of silver until the tenth year of Ibbi-Zikir (he remained therefore in his position for almost thirty years). Other lords marking

a degree of continuity between the two ministers are Gaba-damu, Ilgušti, Iram-malik, IrNIba and possibly Ibišum (see Table III).

Of the two judges, di-ku<sub>5</sub>, of Ibrium's last years, Iš-damu remains in his post while Ille-išar is replaced by GanuLUM. In the 8th year GanuLUM disappears and is replaced by Iram-damu. These judges, from the fifth year of Ibrium on, made deliveries only of clothing. In the documents of Ibrium, the two judges appeared in the list of lords, generally at the beginning. With Ibbi-Zikir, instead, their deliveries of clothing are recorded after the total quantity of silver given by the lords (texts IV 1-3). From the fourth year on their deliveries appear in the third section of the text.

In the 13th year, the names of the other lords also disappear from the annual texts of Ibbi-Zikir. On the eve of Ebla's fall, economic power laid almost entirely in the hands of the minister himself.
